THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN BRICKENDON LANE, BRICKENDON/HERTFORD AND B158 PORT HILL, HERTFORD) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14[1] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"), except for access and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time on both sides of these lengths of Roads whilst works are in progress:-

1. that length of Brickendon Lane, Brickendon/Hertford from its junction with Pembridge Lane north eastwards, northwards, north eastwards and north westwards to its northernmost junction with Mendeville Road ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 3781 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Brickendon Green, Bayford Road, Well Row, Bayford Lane, Broad Green, B158 (Lower Hatfield Road/Horns Mill Road) and Brickendon Lane.

2. that length of B158 Port Hill, Hertford from its junction with B158 Cowbridge north eastwards, north westwards and north eastwards to its junction with Warren Park Road, a distance of approximately 476 metres.

An alternative route will be via B158 (Cowbridge/Old Cross/Mill Bridge/The Wash/Parliament Square/Castle Street), A414 (Gascoyne Way/London Road/Rush Green Link), A10 (unnamed road), A602 Westmill Road and B158 (Wadesmill Road/Bengeo Street).

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

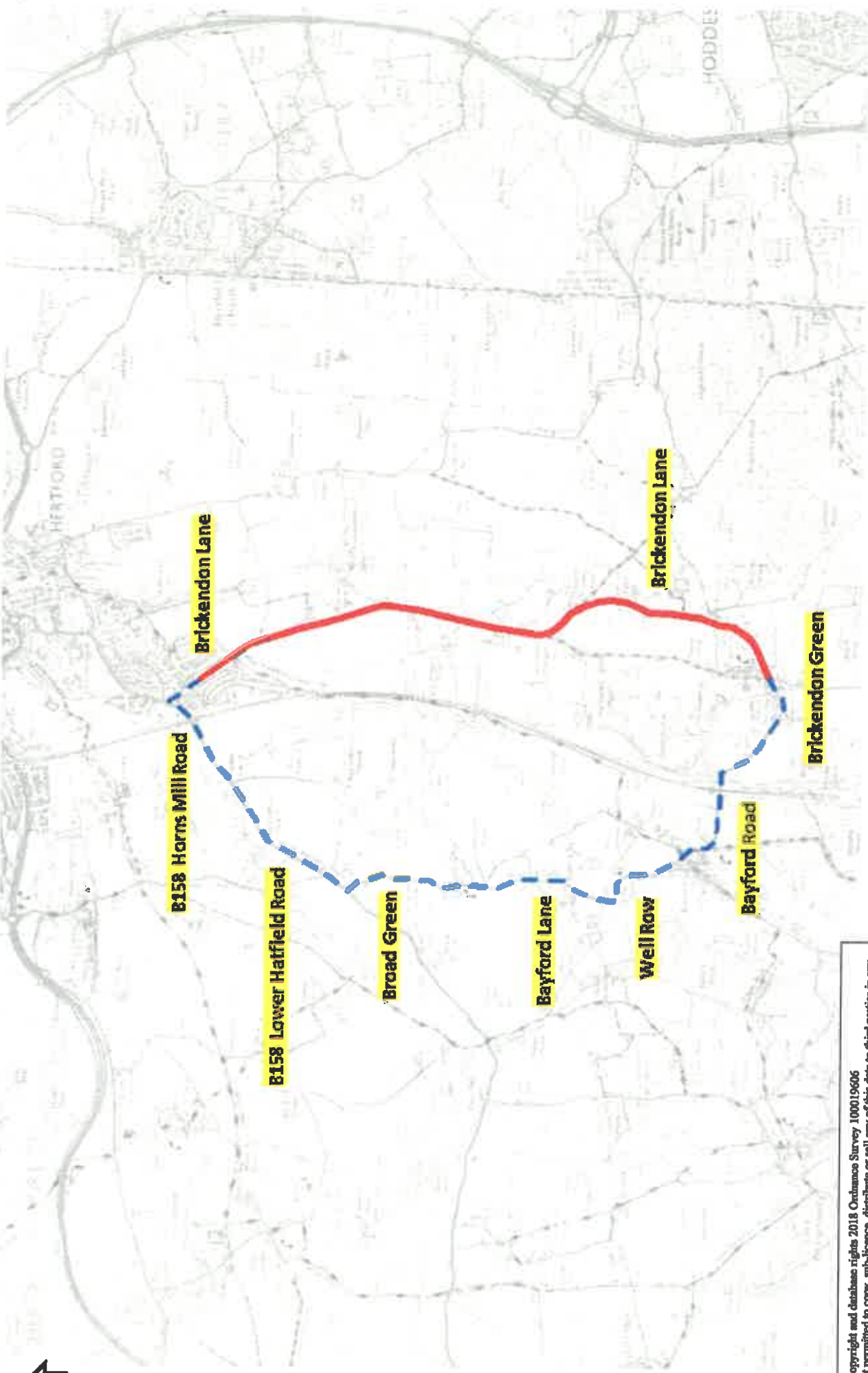
If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 1 June 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
