- Electric Car Charging Points: this has been agreed in principle by the PC and installation should take place in the coming financial year.
- A Jubilee bench and plaque will be sited in a designated area of Brickendon Green and is now being researched. In view of recent events, consideration is being given to renaming the area the Elizabeth II Garden with a further memorial.
- Defibrillators continue to be placed around the parish
