Parish Council update:

<u>At their re-scheduled November meeting on 8 December</u> the PC discussed, among other things:

Maintenance to the village hall – Further work and decisions to be made about the Jubilee Garden – FRC events – Local crime – Planning applications – Highways matters including disappearing drain covers in WWE – Environmental matters, including extending the path from Bayford station to the Hall - More defibrillators and a litter pick in 2023.

At the meeting on 26 January the following items were on the Agenda or raised by members of the public present:

Benches on Brickendon Green are scheduled to be renovated – Benches for the Jubilee Garden have been purchased and will shortly be put in place, a plaque will be ordered – Crime figures in the parish are low but residents should remain vigilant particularly of theft from outbuildings and vehicle crime – Drains have been cleared in the area – Although not in our parish, a representation has been made by a resident to relevant authorities to have the gully at the end of Brickendon Lane cleared to prevent future serious flooding – The PC are planning to renovate and replace roadside verge posts as necessary and will pay for this

work – Ownership of verges in the Parish is still unclear – Quotations have now been received for extending the path from Bayford station and one will now be accepted. **Further information on PC meetings can be found in the Minutes which are published on <u>www.brickendon-liberty.org.uk</u>**

23 March - 25 May - 27 July - 28 September - 23 November

All meetings are held in Fanshaws Room (the Village Hall) on Brickendon Green and local residents are encouraged to attend. Meetings usually start at 7.30pm.
